
## **BOSTON MODERN ORCHESTRA PROJECT**

Anthony Paul De Ritis and the Boston Modern Orchestra Project present a wholly unique disc with Devolution. De Ritis's first orchestral work, Chords of Dust, is named after a collection of poems by his father and was written after his first summer at Fontainebleau, France. Legerdemain came from ideas gathered during a second summer in France, using orchestral textures and a reverb/delay processor to manipulate the music. De Ritis's use of electronics is exemplified in Devolution, a concerto for DJ and orchestra. DJ Spooky turntables the orchestra in real time, creating a different result with each live performance. Anthony Paul De Ritis proves his mastery of new electronic music.
