

Highbrow meets lowbrow, funky meets cultured, and soloists meet their shadowy doubles in the music of Anthony Paul De Ritis, which cheerfully refuses to stay in a stylistic box. This is BMOP's second release of the Boston-based composer's work, continuing an ambitious discography of contemporary orchestral music. Pop Concerto for Guitar and Orchestra, written for the celebrated guitar virtuoso Eliot Fisk, is a virtuosic exploration of the sound, groove, and textures of four landmark pop songs. Amsterdam is a kinetic, energetic orchestral showpiece, while Riflessioni features bassoonist Patrick de Ritis (no relation to the composer) in an interactive setting of electronic reflections and echoes. The infectious Ballet underscores the composer's enduring devotion to the rhythms of dance; highlighted on this track is Duo X88, made up of pianists Vicky Chow and Saskia Lankhoorn. They shine along with the musicians of BMOP in this spirited rendering of creative and ebullient orchestral music for the modern world.
