William Schuman (1910-1992) was a vital force in American musical life as a composer and administrator, holding posts as President of Juilliard and Lincoln Center, among others. As a composer he built a strong relationship with modern dance pioneer Martha Graham. This release from BMOP/sound collects three of his collaborations with her spanning 20 years. *Judith, Choreographic Poem* recounts the biblical tale of Judith beheading Holfernes. *Night Journey* tells the story of Oedipus from Jocasta's perspective. Receiving its first commercial recording release, *The Witch of Endor* returns to the stories of the Bible to explore the meeting between a seer and King Saul.
